

Conditions of Sale

Admittance is at the discretion of the auctioneers. The auctioneers reserve the right to refuse admission, or to eject any person, at any time without giving reason.

This is a cash only auction. The auctioneers will not accept cheques, cards, promises etc. and it is the buyer's responsibility to ensure he is able to pay for a lot before bidding.

All persons attending the auction do so at their own risk, and shall have no claim against the auctioneers in respect of any accident, injury, damage or loss howsoever caused.

Catalogue descriptions are for identification purposes only, and are as supplied to us. Buyers must satisfy themselves as to the description and condition of a lot at the time of sale, before bidding.

All damage to lots must be paid for at the reserve price, or in the absence of a reserve, at a price set by the auctioneers. The auctioneers shall not be responsible for any loss or damage whatsoever.

All electrical items are sold as not working. The auctioneers accept no responsibility for the electrical safety of any item.

On the fall of the hammer, if the reserve is met, risk shall pass to the bidder, who shall be deemed the buyer. However, title shall not pass to the buyer until payment is received in full.

A buyer's premium of 10% of the hammer price will be added to each item.

The auctioneers shall not disclose the identity of, or release any other personal details about any buyer or seller to a third party. However, in the case of a defaulting buyer, details of that buyer shall be passed to the seller for persual of monies owed. The auctioneers accept no responsibility whatsoever in the case of default.

No lot may be removed from the saleroom until payment has been received in full. No lot may be paid for and removed until the end of the auction.

The auctioneers shall not pay out on any lot until payment has been received from the buyer in full.

There is to be no buying or selling in the carpark whatsoever.
