**Important: If you're using a Satnav, please also read the directions below, otherwise you'll get lost! For the purpose of these directions, traffic lights at pedestrian crossings are not included.**

The venue is easily accessible from the city centre inner ring road, which is in itself easily accessible from the M1/M69, M6, A444, A45.

Leave the city centre via the A4114 the Holyhead Road, and keep going straight, you will cross a set of traffic lights with Morrisons Supermarket on your left.

Continue over the next set of traffic lights, with The Holyhead Pub on your right.

Continue until the next set of traffic lights immediately after a row of shops on your left and turn right at these lights onto Kingsbury Road.

You are now in a housing estate. Drive on past a pub on the right and keep going until the road bears round to the right.

**DO NOT FOLLOW AROUND THE CORNER INTO SHORNCLIFFE ROAD! THERE ARE ONLY HOUSES THERE, AND NO ACCESS TO THE VENUE.**

At the very end of Kingsbury Rd you will see a narrow lane which leads to The Social Club.

Please cut off and bring to the auction.
